Multi-platinum rockers P.O.D. bring a resume of chart-topping radio hits, sold-out international concert tours, and three #1 videos on MTV's Total Request Live. Their groundbreaking 2001 release, *Satellite*, featured hit singles including, "Alive," "Youth of the Nation" and "Boom."

Hoobastank sprouted in the Los Angeles suburbs at a battle-of-the-bands contest over ten years ago. Since then, the band has found success balancing heavy alternative rock with a California groove. This post-grunge foursome continues to rule the airwaves with hits including "Same Direction" and "The Reason."

Philly native Garrett Dutton, a.k.a. G. Love, and Special Sauce's James Prescott and Jeffrey Clemens, broke into the limelight with their self-titled debut in 1994.
